Shimizu Port Day News

Your ship docks at Hinode Pier, essentially in the middle of town: a shopping complex 5 minutes on foot, a fish market 10 minutes further, and Mt. Fuji, a UNESCO pine grove and a mountainside shrine all within a 20-minute ride.

△ FIRST, CHECK YOUR DAY OF THE WEEK — more plans die on closing days than on anything else	
Monday	Verkehr Museum, Toro ruins museum, Sunpu Castle buildings (parks and grounds stay open)
Tuesday	Jirocho's Birthplace. Nihondaira Yume Terrace closes on the 2nd Tuesday only
Wednesday	Kashi no Ichi fish market — the big one to know
Any weekday	Yamauchiya strawberry farm (weekends and holidays only, roughly Dec–May)

15–20 MIN BY FOOT, BOAT OR TAXI

Kashi no Ichi — tuna bowl lunch	10 min walk · closed Wed
Water bus across the harbor	¥1,000 leg · ¥1,800 loop
Bay cruise (40 min)	¥2,000 · 11:30/13/14/15
Shimizu Ginza arcade	20 min walk · covered

IF IT RAINS

Dream Plaza → Sushi Museum → Kashi no Ichi (under cover) → Ginza arcade. A day that works with no mountain in sight.

HALF A DAY · BY TAXI

Miho no Matsubara (UNESCO) — 15–20 min by taxi, ¥2,500–3,500 each way, free to enter. 30,000 pines and the Mt. Fuji view from the ukiyo-e prints.

Nihondaira + Kunozan Toshogu — 20 min taxi, ropeway ¥1,250 return, shrine ¥700. About ¥3,500–5,000 per person all in, done independently.

THE CLASSIC FIRST VISIT · 5–6 HOURS

Fuji from the deck at dawn → taxi to Miho no Matsubara → water bus back → tuna lunch at the market → souvenirs at Dream Plaza. Comfortably under ¥6,000 per person.

On Mt. Fuji, honestly: the mountain hides often. Summer afternoons are close to a coin flip against you, and mornings beat afternoons in every season. Build a day that is still good if the mountain never shows.

Local notes: taxis at the pier are walk-up, no booking needed, and everything within walking distance needs no reservation. Confirm your ship's all-aboard time on board — it is the one deadline that matters.
